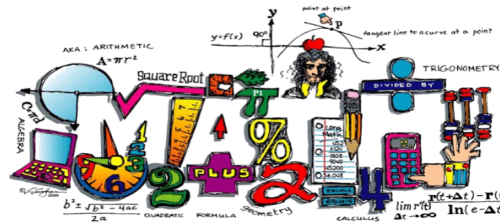


# Gilford Middle School 2019 Summer Math Academy



**July 9 - August 16, 2019**

(Offered to current 4<sup>th</sup>– 8<sup>th</sup> grade students at no cost)

During the summer break, it is critical for students to continue practicing their math skills, retain their mathematics knowledge, and have an opportunity for advancement. All students can benefit from extended intervention and support, or enriched, individualized instruction.

The GMS Summer Mathematics Academy offers current grades 4 – 8 students math enrichment, practice, and intervention through various math activities (math games and cooking) and online math programs. Based on Common Core Math Standards, the online programs include Khan Academy(based on Eureka Math modules/lessons) and Reflex Math for math fact family practice. These programs are currently used as resources in K – 8 math instruction.

Reports from the online programs provide individual progress data that informs individualized and small group instruction. Additionally, the data provides GMS and GHS math staff with information to address specific student learning needs at the start of the 2019-2020 school year.

The GMS Summer Math Academy staff includes GMS math teachers, and other staff. A variety of resources and strategies are used to enrich and/or raise individual skill levels, depending on your child's needs.
